- As the Unlock Phase started, the office and the library started functioning in the premises.
- Dry grocery was distributed to needy students with the support of individuals/corporate.
- Online classes continued, students appeared for competitive tests and exams
- Braille printing was done for junior classes, books were dispatched.
- Online computer classes conducted for students who has a computer at home and trained based on their needs.
- Teachers communicated with the parents of the students periodically.
- 15 students were selected for admission in Class I and Class II in October '20 Their schedule was formed, and books were dispatched.
- Accessible books, Teaching-Learning aids were shared with the students.
- Continuous online classes and connect with the students and their families.
- Smartphones provided to 30 visually impaired children.
- Monetary assistance for a few students for laptop repair.
- Periodic recharge of mobile phones.
- Assistance to for assessment assignments, projects and exams.
